



1 RESPONSIBILITIES STEMMING FROM PARTICIPATION

- 1.1 The player is free to enter AVC Official Beach Volleyball events and should not be constrained by any organization to do so or not. In the case of entering, the player must respect and abide by the AVC Regulations, which breach of many lead to the loss of his/her eligibility to take part in any Official national and international Beach Volleyball and Volleyball competitions including, without limitation to, AVC Beach Volleyball Circuit and Asian Beach Volleyball Championships.
- 1.2 The player requiring authorisation from an organisation other than his/her own National Federation may not enter AVC Official events, and a player taking part in tournaments not authorised by the AVC, or playing in a foreign country without a previous written invitation from the local National Association commits a serious breach of the AVC regulations and may be sanctioned with the loss of eligibility as mentioned in the previous paragraph, without any other formality.
- 1.3 The player violating any of the above regulations or other reiterated violations might cause the AVC to impose heavy fines against the player involved.
- 1.4 The player is expected neither to claim nor to request any payment other than prize money.
- 1.5 The player is responsible for being informed of the starting time of all matches and of being present and ready on time. Players should also be available for local promotion whenever requested by the promoter and/or the host National Federation if it would not interfere with their preparation or scheduled matches.
- 1.6 Upon signing the agreement to enter AVC Beach Volleyball events the player accepts:
 - a) The obligation to submit himself/herself to anti-doping Controls conducted in accordance with the AVC regulations and to Gender Verification (women only).
 - b) The obligation to obtain from his/her NF or NOC, the list of forbidden substances/products en-listed in the IOC Doping Regulations and to accept the disciplinary measures taken by the AVC.
 - c) To recognise the exclusive competence of the International Court for ARbitration in Sports recognised by the IOC, the AVC and the NOCs and, furthermore, waive any right to appeal to a civil court regarding this issue.

2 FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

- 2.1 Before entering an AVC Beach Volleyball official event the player must present a medical attestation declaring he/she is in good health to participate in Beach Volleyball events and state that he/she assumes total responsibility for any health problems that may occur to him/her, except for injuries, during the AVC Beach Volleyball official event.
- 2.2 The Player will be compensated on the basis of his/her performance by way of prize money, which will be paid by the local organizer on site.
- 2.3 He/she acknowledges the right to authorise his/her National Federation or a representative from his/her country to receive prize money payments on his/her behalf.
- 2.4 With the exception of prize money, he/she is not expecting to be paid any other money or offered other values, except for expenses which payment will not be conditioned upon his/her success in the tournament. He/she will do his/her utmost to provide, by the deadline stated in the Events Regulations, the travel itinerary to the hosting NF concerned.

3 THE AVC GRANTS THE PLAYER THE RIGHT TO:

- 3.1 Use during the competitions the following accessories: visor or cap, sunglasses, footwear (with

approval from referees), kneepades, support braces (with approval from the AVC Technical Supervisor), one (1) watch, one (1) armband (maximum width 10 cm) or one (1) temporary tattoo. The player may have only one (1) armband or one (1) temporary tattoo, not both. Such armband or temporary tattoo must be located on the upper arm only.

(Each accessory may have only one (1) manufacturer's logo of max. 20 cm² and only for each side of the towel, two (2) personal sponsors' logo not exceeding 72 cm². No additional logos will be allowed on any other accessories)

- 3.2 Wear his/her own shorts/bathing suit bottom provided that they are in line with UNIFORMS STANDARDS, present the same colour and style as his/her partner's and the AVC logo reserved space is left free.
- 3.3 Have up to a maximum of four (4) personal sponsorship patches (including manufacturer) on his/her shorts/bathing suit bottom located in any position as long as the total sum of all logos does not exceed 300 cm².

4 THE PLAYER COMMITS TO THE FOLLOWING:

- 4.1 Not to wear a patch or logo of any other organization except his/her country flag and AVC logo.
- 4.2 To wear the official tank-top/top as distributed by the tournament organiser/promoter and his/her own shorts/bathing suit bottom approved (with personal sponsorship patches and AVC badge whenever provided by the AVC) during: warm-ups, competitions, ceremonies and interviews after the match. Not to alter the official tank-top/top in any way or cover the official AVC identification or local sponsors on the official uniform.
- 4.3 To submit his/her own shorts/bathing suit bottom and any accessories including temporary tattoos or medical braces for approval by the AVC Technical Supervisor during the Preliminary Inquiry before the tournament and once approved, not to include any new sponsors' logo/name on shorts, bathing suitbottoms, hats, caps, bags, arm pads, head bands, etc., nor to conclude new agreements with companies willing to sign a last minute deal during the event unless specifically authorised in writing by the promoter of the event.

5 THE PLAYER HEREBY GRANTS THE AVC AND AVC OFFICIAL SPONSORS/SUPPLIERS:

- 5.1 The right to reproduce in computer assisted and computer related games embodied in or on any device or medium in the form of software, firmware and/or hardware which may be utilised directly or indirectly for the reproduction of visual images with or without sound of the AVC Beach Volleyball Circuit or Asian Beach Volleyball Championships matches real or simulated but always with reference to the AVC Beach Volleyball Circuit or Asian Beach Volleyball Championship.
- 5.2 The right to licence assign or transfer the rights and licenses mentioned herein at their sole discretion to any third party.
- 5.3 The right to make use of and show, at its discretion, any motion pictures, video games, magazines including live, taped or filmed television footage or photos of the player taken during AVC official events without compensation, and hereby waives any right to such compensation for the player, his/her heirs and assignees.

Have read, understood and hereby agree with the content of this agreement. I undertake to forward one (1) signed copy to the National Federation/local organiser of the event in question and one (1) copy to the AVC.
