

## 2017 Chinese Youth Handball Summer Camp Program

### 1. Event Holder

- 1) Event holder: Chinese Handball Association
- 2) Organizer: Sports Administration of Dalian
- 3) Assistant: Dalian Sports Center

### 2. Date and Venue

- 1) Date: 14 July – 17 July 2017 (Arrival on 13 July and departure on 18 July)
- 2) Venue: Dalian Sports Center (Dalian, Liaoning, China)

### 3. Participants

- 1) Mainland China, Primarily and Middle Schools
- 2) Handball Association of Hong Kong China
- 3) Handball Association of Macau China
- 4) Handball Committee of Dali Taichung Chinese Taipei
- 5) Danish Club
- 6) Hungarian Club

### 4. Participation

- 1) Age Groups

U12: Boys and Girls, Born 1st Jan. 2005 or later

U18: Boys and Girls, Born 1st Jan. 1999 or later

## 2) Eligibility

- (1) Up to two (2) teams from each participant are allowed to play in each of the four groups. The host could send more teams according to the number of participating teams.
- (2) All players must meet the age limitation of his/her group.
- (3) Each team consists of 4 team officials and 14 players.
- (4) All players must bring his/her identity documents (Passport etc.) to the event for eligibility check at the technical meeting.
- (5) Players must have physical certificate to prove their health condition good for competition. Teams are obliged to insure all team members, i. e. all players and all officials, against unexpected injury, accident and sickness, at their own cost.

## 3) Registration and Arrival

### (1) Registration

Fill in the attached Registration Form, Signed by secretary general of local handball association or schoolmaster, send both the digital form and the signed copy to the following mail box before 31 May, 2017:

### (2) Arrival

Teams should arrive in Dalian Sports Center at the latest by 18:00, 13 July, 2017.

### (3) Eligibility check

Technical meeting will be held at 20:00, 13 July, 2017. Eligibility check will be conducted at the meeting.

### (4) Departure for home

Teams will departure for home on 18 July, 2017.

## 5. Technical Section

### 1) Number of players on the court

Seven (7) players for each team for both group U12 and U18.

### 2) Single round robin will be played when there're 5 teams registered in one age group. Preliminary matches will be played in groups when there're 6 or more teams registered in one age group, then knock-out section will be played.

Note: No over time will be played when a single round robin match finished draw.

After 5 min break, 7m throw will be conducted to decide the winner when a knock-out match or placement match finished draw,

### 3) Match Time

U12: 2x15min

U18: 2x20min

With 10 min half time break and 2 team time-out for each team in one match.

### 4) Match evaluation and determination of places

(1) The preliminary round is played in groups (Single round robin). The matches shall be evaluated as follows:

- each match won = 2 points
- each match drawn = 1 point for each team
- each match lost = no points

Teams are ranked according to the total number of points gained.

(2) If two or more teams have gained the same number of points after the group matches have been completed, classification is decided as follows:

- results in points between the teams concerned



- goal differences in the matches between the teams concerned
- greater number of plus goals in the matches between the teams concerned.

If the teams are still equal, a decision is made between those teams with equal number of points as follows:

- goal difference is subtracted in all matches
- greater number of plus goals in all matches.

If classification still is not possible, a draw shall decide. The event representative on site shall execute the draw, if possible in the presence of the 'responsible team officials'. If the 'responsible team official' cannot be present, other co-workers selected by the IHF shall take part.

#### 5) Players' uniforms

Each team must possess two differently coloured sets of players' uniforms (goalkeeper's colour must distinguish them from the court players of both teams and the goalkeeper(s) of the opposing team).

Players must wear clearly legible numbers, the figures being placed at least 20cm high on the back and at least 10cm high on their chest. The numbers shall be in a different color from the uniform main color.

Uniform color shall appear on the team registration form.

#### 6) Playing Rules and Ball Size

U12: CHA Mini Handball Rules. IHF Size 1.

U18: The latest IHF "Playing Rules of the Game". IHF Size 2.

### 6. Awards

- 1) Trophies and certificates shall be awarded to the three top teams
- 2) Plates and certificates shall be awarded to the rest teams
- 3) Certificates and souvenirs shall be awarded to the MVP of the team

which nominated by his/her team.

- 4) Certificates and souvenirs shall be awarded to the coach of the top team of each group.
- 5) CHA will present certificates of "Contribution to the Event" to the participating Association and Clubs.

## 7. Featured activities

- 1) Technical Connor, exchange training activities, games, and local sightseeing.
- 2) Closing Party and Awarding Ceremony.
- 3) Each team shall prepare one program to show the players' talent and school demeanor on the Closing Party.

## 8. Financial Section

Participating teams should bear their travel expenses, board and lodging.

The board and lodging fee are as follows:

Registered persons (18): 40 USD / per person / per day

Additional persons: 60 USD / per person / per day

Organizer will provide pick up service from / to the local airport and railway station.
